## Parents are the First Teachers

As parents, the first 1000 days of your tamariki's life are crucial. The first 3 years of your baby's life will help shape them into the person they will be in the future. Aroha, nurture, and strong family values will be the foundation for the future success of your children. That is the number one responsibility of all parents.

Parents are the 1st teachers, parents who invest time into their children's preschool years and beyond will generally produce well-adjusted, young people with bright futures ahead of them.

Once children start school then teachers support, promote and develop the great work that families have done.

We are educators, our primary responsibility is to academically educate our beautiful children. We also provide the love and care all children require.

The role of a teacher is becoming increasingly difficult as we are expected to correct poor behaviour, teach family values and far too often try to rectify behaviour that is at an extreme level. This is the responsibility of parents and whanau, but it appears to have fallen into the job description of primary school teachers.

For the majority of families, children start school and we get straight into learning, it is an exciting time for both the teachers and the tamariki.

Sadly, however, an increasing number of children are arriving at school with heightened aggression, using inappropriate language, limited resilience and the inability to socialise with their peers.

It is a national problem and we have noticed it at Western Heights Primary School particularly over the past 2 years. I believe society has taken a backward step, but it is not too late to turn things around.

The language we use in our homes, the love we show our kids and our partners, parents parenting together, and having firm boundaries and expectations that promote respect, kindness and whanaungatanga are so important for the development of our children.

A child surrounded by love, support and firm, fair and fun parents will blossom.

Some children are born with neurodiversity and schools have some resources and external resourcing to support these children but we are completely under-resourced to deal with students who arrive at school displaying learned negative behaviour.

I want to thank our families who have children at school with difficult behaviours for your support. It is greatly appreciated. If we work together then we can achieve anything.

If you are struggling, please make contact with the school. We may not have all the answers but we may be able to steer you in the right direction.

The greatest honour presented to us in life is to be parents. The joy it brings is immeasurable but it's not easy. It takes true investment, commitment, dedication and unconditional aroha for our beautiful tamariki.

Western Heights Primary is a joy to be part of, thank you for supporting our kaupapa. We want every child to be a success. It starts in the home and is supported at school.

Over the past 2 weeks we have had a number of teachers fall ill. Sadly there are very few releif teachers around to replace them. We do on occassion have to split classes to cover all room.
